

Apostolic Visit of our Holy Father, Pope Francis, to the United States



Pope Francis will be visiting the United States from Tuesday, September 22 until Sunday, September 27. He will visit Washington, DC, New York City and Philadelphia. While in New York, the Holy Father will pray the Evening Prayer (Vespers) at St Patrick's Cathedral, visit the Memorial of the World Trade Center, a Catholic school in Harlem and offer Mass at Madison Square Garden.

Where to see the Pope

Most events attended by the Pope are ticketed. Tickets for events in New York were reserved for parishes of the Archdiocese of New York, which means that New Jersey-based parishes have no way of providing tickets.

Relevant Radio and WNSW-1430 AM will be bringing wallto-wall coverage of the Papal Visit for the entire time that His Holiness will be with us. Every key event and Mass LIVE from Washington, DC, to New York, to Philadelphia, from his arrival on September 22 to his departure on September 27.



National Tour of the Relics of St Maria Goretti



On Monday, September 21, the Catholic Basilica of the Sacred Heart–Mother Church of the Archdiocese of Newark – will be the first stop on a national tour of the Major Relics of St. Maria Goretti—the Little Saint of Great Mercy.

This tour, designed as an introduction to the observance of a world-wide Extraordinary Holy Year of Mercy, will run from September 21 through November 13 and visit locations in 16 states and 25 dioceses across the country. It is the first time that the Relics of St Maria Goretti, an immensely popular saint, have traveled to the United States, and only the second time that they have been taken on pilgrimage outside of St Maria's native land of Italy. The full schedule for the day will be:

- 9 am − 7 pm − Veneration
- 7 pm Celebration of Mass
- 8-11 pm-Veneration

Presentations on the life and virtues of St Maria Coretti, the youngest person (she died at the age of 11) ever to be canonized by the Church, arealso planned for the day.


Religious Education News

Safeguarding Children and **Addressing Abuse**

The Catholic Church is Battling Abuse

Archbishop Myers has stated categorically that the primary responsibilities of the Archdiocese are to protect children and young people, and to promote the healing of, and provide compassion to, victims of abuse.

The Archdiocese of Newark requires all staff and volunteers working with children and youth to undergo background checks and receive sexual abuse awareness training. More than 20,000 Clergy, Religious and Lay people have received this training and undergone criminal background checks.

Nearly 95,000 children annually receive safe environment training through our Catholic schools and through opportunities offered to public school students in our religious education programs.

The Archdiocese utilizes the services of a Licensed Clinical Social Worker as the first contact for individuals who allege that they were abused so that counseling and other support services can be offered immediately if appropriate - sometimes even before a determination is made regarding the credibility of an allegation.

A full-time Office of Child and Youth Protection dedicated to protecting children works with parishes and schools to ensure that safe environments are in place throughout the Archdiocese.

Baptism Information

Baptisms take place on the 1st Sunday of every Month: 2 Baptisms per Mass at 10 AM & Noon



Because they will be promising to help raise your child in the practice of the Faith. the church re-

quires that at least one of your child's godparents be a 'fully initiated Roman Catholic;' i.e., one who has been Baptized and received the sacraments of Holy Communion and Confirmation. At the time of registering your child for Baptism, we ask that one of your chosen godparents provide a copy of their Confirmation certificate or some documentation from their church of Baptism or Confirmation indicating the month and year of their Confirmation. 


