## Archbishop's Annual Appeal ---Making a Difference

The Office of Pastoral Ministry with the Deaf brings Christ's message to those who cannot hear. This special ministry arranges Sign Language Masses, sacramental preparation for the young and Pre-Cana couples, pastoral counseling in Sign Language, visits with the Deaf in hospitals, nursing homes, prisons, schools and wherever access to or advocacy with social and spiritual services or healthcare are needed and communication barriers are present.

Each Sunday there is a Sign Language Mass at St. John's Church in Newark and 50 deaf people travel from all parts of the Archdiocese to be part of this community. In addition, the Office of Pastoral Ministry arranges Sign Language interpreters for Sunday Mass at five other parishes and sacramental access in many more within the Archdiocese.

Last year this ministry helped over 300 people including not only the Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing but their families, community members and interpreting students. In addition, it provided Sign Language instruction to priests and others, and presented in-service trainings on Deaf Spirituality and Deaf Awareness at nursing homes.

Thank you for your support of the Archbishop's Annual Appeal, which helps those with hearing loss become active members of the Church in the Archdiocese of Newark.


## First Friday Healing Mass with Fr. Bill
