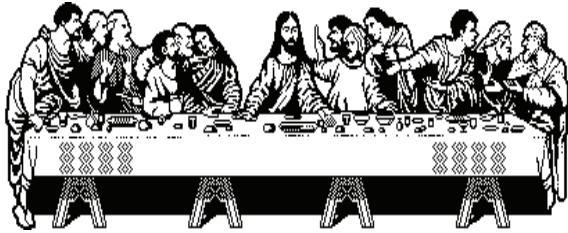

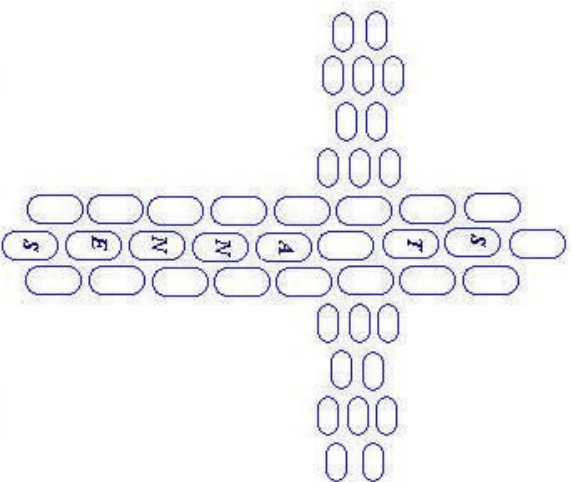


### VOCATIONS
