<u>A non-refundable Registration Fee is \$15/per child</u>; Weekly cost is \$35 a week <u>per child</u>. If your child attends one day for the week, the full payment of \$35 is paid. If there is a holiday where Star-Lite will be closed for 2 days, the fee will remain \$35. Keep in mind, when there are ½ days for school, your child will be at Star-Lite for 6 hours. Children will be picked up after school if they attend St. Anne's School;otherwise, transportation is responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Since Star-Lite is funded by the City of Jersey City, there is an Income Sheet Form that MUST be filled out at the time of registration by parents whose children attend Star Lite.
