Religious Education News A Note from Sister Alberta

Thanks be to God! I am back for good! I want to thank everyone for all their prayers for my recovery. I will be in the Religious Education Office on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays effective Monday, August 25. New and returning registration for the 2008-2009 CCD school year is now taking place. Parents who have registered their children but have not picked up their children's class card or have yet to pay the registration fee are reminded to do so.

As I was laid up due to my injury, I will need the added cooperation of the parents to get myself up to speed before the **first CCD class on September 21st**. It is important that as much as possible is completed before classes begin in respect to registration matters. <u>Please call the office at 201-659-1794 before coming so as to confirm that I am in the office.</u>

Just a reminder for those parents of children in grade one, First Penance and Communion takes place in second grade. The preparation for these sacraments is required to take two years so if you wish to have your child receive these sacraments in grade two, you need to have your child attend first grade in our Religious Education Program. Children who come to CCD in grade 2 who <u>have not</u> already completed a year of religious education elsewhere or who have previously been enrolled in a non-Catholic school will be placed back one year in order to meet the preparation requirements.

All new registrants need to bring a copy of their child's **baptism certificate.** Please be advised that all children in grades kindergarten through eighth grade who are Catholic and attend either a public or charter school should be enrolled in CCD regardless if they are to receive a sacrament this year or not, children need to learn about their Faith. It is your responsibility to provide your children with the knowledge and love of our Catholic Faith. The registration fee is \$50.00 for the year and includes the costs of materials and textbooks.

In previous years, we were unable to have a kindergarten class due to lack of students. I know many have expressed interest so it is important that you register your kindergarten age child. If we get at least five students to register this year, we will have a kindergarten class, so if you know of anyone else, please encourage them to register their child.

As the new CCD school year approaches, I once again find myself **in need of teachers for Sunday mornings in various grades**. No previous experience is necessary; a formation program to help new catechists become prepared and certified to teach is already in place. Why not share your love of Jesus with His children by teaching His Faith? <u>Anyone who is interested in teaching should call me at 201-659-1794</u>. Please pray for the children, and the catechists, and all the volunteers as we approach a new year of instruction.
