BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP FACILITATOR TRAINING COURSE

Are you interested in becoming part of the ministry to the bereaved in your parish? An eight-week training program is offered by the Office of Family Life Ministries of the Archdiocese of Newark and is now open for registration. Participants will explore the stages and tasks of grief and mourning and develop their communication and group facilitation skills. Sessions begin in September and continue into November and are offered on Tuesday mornings at the Archdiocesan Center in Newark or on Thursday evenings in the parish center of St. Thomas the Apostle RC Church in Bloomfield; **Tuition is \$150 per participant.**

STAR-LITE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

September 8th, 2008 to June 12th, 2009 Hours are 2:45 to 6 p.m.

This After School Program is available to children in grades K thru 8 located in "The Heights" of Jersey City. Registration is now being accepted.

Registration forms are NOW available at St. Anne's Rectory or through St. Anne's School Office in September. All forms, <u>including ADVANCED PAYMENT for two weeks</u>, are to be dropped off at St. Anne's School Office or St. Anne's Rectory ONLY. Payments will no longer be made at the Star-Lite building.

A non-refundable Registration Fee is \$15/per child; Weekly cost is \$35 a week per child. If your child attends one day for the week, the full payment of \$35 is paid. If there is a holiday where Star-Lite will be closed for 2 days, the fee will remain \$35. Keep in mind, when there are ½ days for school, your child will be at Star-Lite for 6 hours.

Children will be picked up after school if they attend St. Anne's School; otherwise, transportation is responsibility of the parent/guardian.

Since Star-Lite is funded by the City of Jersey City, there is an Income Sheet Form that MUST be filled out at the time of registration by parents whose children attend Star Lite. This is necessary paperwork needed for the CDGB Funding Report for the City of Jersey City. We appreciate your cooperation. Thank you.
