



FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR.....

To the Congregation of St. Anne's Parish -

At our latest Finance Committee Meeting held January 12, 2009, it was suggested that an Accounts Payable Report be publicized for a better understanding of the current financial status of St. Anne's Parish (see below). Current Parish debt is \$167,881.00 - all of which is owed to the Archdiocese of Newark - Church owing \$106,255; School owing \$61,626.00. However, all other vendor bills are currently up-to-date.

I'm aware of the current economic situation, which no doubt, has affected all of us. However, I publicize this information in hopes you will understand the Parish's financial concerns. We currently have a \$50.00 50/50 in hopes to bring some money in to help with roof repairs of the church and school. If at all possible, I'm appealing to you for 'a little extra' in your collection envelopes. It would be very helpful. Thank you.
