To help with cost, the 1099 Forms have been **mailed** only to those parishioners who contributed \$250 or more for 2008; if needed, those who contributed less than \$250, are requested to contact the rectory to receive a 1099 Form.

St. Anne's Parish Records indicate the following:

- **1264 families** are **REGISTERED PARISHIONERS**; **1123 families** registered for envelopes
- **440 families of 1123- ACTIVELY** use church envelopes;
- **683 families of 1123–** are **NON-ACTIVE** (choose not to use collection envelopes)

The Sunday Collection Envelope Mailing List has been recently updated: the status of 300 registered families was "changed from **Active** to **Non-Active**"; these 300 families didn't use envelopes for the year of 2008.

To financially help the parish, envelopes will only be mailed to those who are ACTIVELY using them. If at any time, a registered parishioner would like to change their status and would like to use Sunday collection envelopes, please contact the rectory. Thank you.


