GOSPEL: MARK 9;2-10

#### Reflection on Today's Gospel:

We refer to the Gospel today as the Transfiguration. Peter, James and John alone with Jesus on a mountaintop and they see Jesus "transfigured" (changed) right before their eyes. They see the glory of God shine through Jesus, and they hear a voice from a cloud say, "This is my beloved Son, Listen to Him."
