GOSPEL: JOHN 2:31-25

Reflection on Today's Gospel:

When the disciple in today's Gospel see Jesus drive money changers out of the temple area, they recall the words of scripture - "Zeal for your house will consume me" (psalm 69:10). We don't hear the word "zeal" very often today. If we have zeal for something, we have an intense interest or commitment to something; perhaps a project, a cause, an activity, a belief, even a person, and a zeal that consumes us is, well, very intense.

During this third week in the desert of Lent, we think about how important our faith is in our everyday lives; about how immensely committed we are to living as a Catholic Christian.

Summer Institute for Family Spirituality

The new Catholic Center for Family Spirituality at Immaculate Conception Seminary School of Theology, Seton Hall University invites you to participate in the 2009 William J. Toth Summer Institute for Family Spirituality. The Center was developed in response to Pope John Paul II's challenge to create new institutes dedicated to theological and pastoral dimensions of family life. Summer Institute courses will be conducted at four locations: Ridgewood, Jersey City, Bayonne, and South Orange. Guided by expert faculty, students will examine the spiritual foundations of family life, reflecting on the family as the "Church in miniature" and exploring ways to meet the challenges and stresses attending

modern family life. All courses may be taken for credit towards a Certificate in Spirituality or Pastoral Ministry or towards a Master's Degree in Theology or Pastoral Ministry. Students may also choose to enroll on a non-matriculating basis. Fifty percent discounts and new student scholarships are available for those involved in paid or voluntary Church service.
