

Reflecting On The Gospel - Jesus tells his Apostles a parable about how important it is to pray: A woman goes to a judge to ask for a fair decision in a matter. The judge, however, respects no one and has no fear of God; he will not grant the woman her request. Again and again, the woman goes to the judge - we might say she 'pressures' him. Finally, the judge says she can have the things the way she wants them.
