Evangelization Corner.....

Reflecting On The Gospel - In today's Gospel, we meet a man named Zaccheus. He is not very popular in the town because he's a tax collector; he collects money (taxes) from people and gives it to the Roman authorities. The thing of it is, Zaccheus collects more money than the tax calls for and he keeps that extra for himself. If we had to deal someone like Zaccheus, we wouldn't like that person one bit. But then, Zaccheus has an encounter with Jesus and he becomes a totally different person. This is called a "conversion". He doesn't change his *mind* about things; his whole *heart* is changed.

Sharing Ideas - In what ways might Zaccheus' life have changed because of his "conversion"? Responses might include: "he couldn't afford some luxuries", "he lost most friends who thought he was weird", "he gained more friends because he was more honest"?
