

Visitation of the Sick

Due to the "Privacy Act" to protect patients while being hospitalized, a priest is prohibited from seeing a patient unless requested <u>directly</u> from the <u>patient</u> or an <u>immediate family member</u>. While it is of grave concern for our parishioners to be visited by our parish priests, please keep the "Privacy Act" in mind. Make a Gift Through an IRA Charitable Rollover

- Normally, a distribution from your IRA is taxed as ordinary income. However, tax legislation just enacted extends the opportunity for the remainder of 2010 and throughout 2011 for individuals 70½ or older to make a direct distribution from your IRA to a qualified charity, such as (PARISH NAME), the Archbishop's Annual Appeal, the Archdiocese of Newark, or another archdiocesan institution. Such qualified direct distributions to charity from your IRA are not subject to income tax. The new law also provides that you may consider such distributions made in January 2011 as made in 2010.


