## Evangelization Corner.....

**Reflecting On The Gospel** - In today's Gospel, we hear about a crowd that gathers on the banks of the Jordan River to listen to John the Baptist preach and to be baptized.

Jesus is in the crowd and asks for baptism as well. John's baptism is about penance and the willingness to change one's life. Jesus, who is without sin, receives this baptism in humility.

The baptism Jesus has given us runs much deeper. By his life, death and resurrection, Jesus brought us a new baptism. Jesus gives us his Father to be our Father and himself to be our brother. He makes us brothers and sisters to all others in God's family, the Church. We share the very life of God which saves us from the death of sin.
