## Evangelization Corner.....

**Reflecting On The Gospel** - In today's Gospel, John the Baptist recognizes Jesus as the Messiah and calls him the "Lamb of God".

The lamb represents innocents, and the lamb is a symbol of Jesus because Jesus is God's son innocent in every way. Jesus loves all people and cares for everyone. Jesus loves us so much that he gives up his life to save us from sin. A peacemaker to the end, Jesus loves even those who persecutes him and puts him to death.

Today, as we pray to Jesus—the Lamb of God—lets ask him to give us the grace and courage to love him and our enemies. Let us ask him to show us how to forgive others so that we, too, might be peacemakers.

Sharing Ideas - How can we love people who dislike us, who make trouble for us on purpose? Does loving them mean that we like them? Imagine two countries at war. Make a list of three things each country can do to help bring an end to the war.
