**Reflecting On The Gospel** - In this Gospel, Apostle Paul cannot believe that the other Apostles have seen Jesus. Thomas had not been present when Jesus appeared to them. We know what happened next. Jesus again appears to the Apostles - at a time when Thomas is with them - and Thomas comes to believe that indeed Jesus is raised and lives.

As we imagine what that moment must have been like, we're happy for Thomas that he has the chance to see Jesus and to come to believe that Jesus had been raised from the dead. So might we wish to see Jesus as well?

Perhaps pay very careful attention to what Jesus says to Thomas "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."
