Evangelization Corner.....

Matthew 20:1-16 - Catechetical Sunday - "Do this in memory of me."

Reflecting On The Gospel - Today's Gospel is a parable that Jesus tells to help us better understand that there are some things about God that are baffling. He says that a vineyard owner pays the same amount to everyone who worked in his vineyard - no matter if they worked all day or half a day or only one hour. Everyone got the same pay. What's up with that? In this parable, God isn't teaching us about fair and just business practices, and he isn't teaching us to disregard our standards of what is fair and just. Rather, Jesus uses this parable to help us better understand that God's generous love and justice are far, far different from our standards of love and justice. Jesus uses this situation that is unacceptable by human standards to baffle us, and our faith grows deeper and stronger when we accept that we cannot ever fully comprehend God but love him just the same.

Sharing Ideas - Tell a true story or make up one about someone who is generous beyond human standards.



Septiembre, Mes de la Biblia

La Biblia es una compilación de textos que en un principio eran documentos separados (llamados "libros"), escritos primero en hebreo, arameo y griego durante un dilatado periodo de tiempo y después reunidos para formar el Tanaj (Antiguo Testamento para los cristianos) y luego el Nuevo Testamento. Ambos testamentos forman la Biblia cristiana. En sí la Biblia fue escrita a lo largo de aproximadamente 1000 años (900 a. C. - 100 d. C.).
