

# The Way of The Cross




On Sunday, April 1st at 8:00 pm in St. Anne's Church, the Franciscan Mystery Players will present their moving version of "The Way of the Cross".

Written by Franciscan Father Francis Pompei, the mystery play is not a 'play' in the common sense, but in fact, a prayerful experience that uses special lighting, a stirring soundtrack, pantomine actions and an inspirational narration to portray the Stations of the Cross in a manner that invites each viewer to contemplate the meaning of the Passion and how it relates to their life today.

The group is comprised of teens and adult advisors from several parishes in the Paterson Diocese.

#### PLEASE NOTE CHANGE OF MASS LOCATION....

In an effort to conserve energy and foster a deeper sense of communion, most weekday and Saturday morning Masses will soon be celebrated in our Convent Chapel.

In addition to offering a sacred space that can be more easily heated in the winter and cooled in the summer, the Chapel will provide an intimate gathering space for worship. Sans microphones or special lighting, or vast distances between one another, it will offer an experience of the Eucharist that mirrors that of the very first Believers, gathered together in the Upper Room, experiencing the Crucified and Risen Jesus in their very midst...

The switch will occur on **Wednesday, April 4th** with the evening novena Mass to Our Lady of Perpetual Help and commence in earnest on **Monday, April 9th** with the 7 o'clock morning Mass. Please remember that there are traditionally no morning Masses during the sacred time of Triduum; i.e., Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday; a separate schedule of Masses and Services on these special days will be placed in the next bulletin.

In order to accommodate the students and faculty of Saint Anne School, who usually come together to celebrate the Eucharist once a week and every First Friday of the month, the 9 o'clock morning Mass of each Wednesday and First Friday, when School is in session, will be celebrated in the Church.

As always, thank you for your patience, understanding and support. This is not a decision that was made lightly, but is part of a broader effort to live within our budget and, in the process, perhaps strengthen our sense of connectedness to one another in Christ Jesus.

# Mandamientos para vivir la Cuaresma

- 1. Romperás de una vez por todas con lo que tú bien sabes que Dios no quiere, aunque te agrade mucho, aunque te cueste "horores" dejarlo.
- 2. Compartirás tu pan con el hambriento, tus ropas con el desnudo, tus palabras con el que vive en soledad, tu tiempo y consuelo con el que sufre en el cuerpo o en el alma, tu sonrisa con el triste, tu caridad con TODOS.
- 3. Dedicarás un buen tiempo todos los días para estar a solas con Dios, hablar con Él de corazón a Corazón. Será un tiempo de agradecer, de pedir perdón, de alabarle y adorarle, de suplicar por la salvación de TODOS.
- 4. Confiarás en Dios a pesar de tus pecados y miserias. No permitas que ni dolor, ni pesar alguno, ni las injusticias y traiciones sufridas te hagan dudar ni por un momento del amor infinito que Dios te tiene.
- 5. Mira sólo a Dios y a tus hermanos. Mira a Jesús y habrá paz en tu corazón. Mira las necesidades de tus hermanos y ya no tendrás tiempo de pensar en ti; te harás más humano, más cristiano.
- 6. Ayunarás de palabras vanas. Ayunarás de malos pensamientos: serás puro de corazón. Ayunarás de acciones egoístas. Ayunarás de toda hipocresía: serás veraz.
- 7. Perdonarás una y mil veces a quien te ha herido, con causa o sin ella, justa o injustamente, esté arrepentido o no. Los perdonarás uno por uno, primero en tu corazón y luego, si te es posible, también con tus palabras. No permitirás que el rencor ni el resentimiento envenenen tu corazón.
- 8. Ofrecerás sacrificios agradables al Señor. Los harás en silencio, sin que nadie se dé cuenta. Buscarás con ello reparar por tus pecados y los de TODOS los hombres.
- 9. Amarás la humildad. Reconocerás tus pecados. No buscarás los honores, ni los puestos, ni el poder, ni la fama, que todo eso es de Dios.
- 10. Anunciarás a los hombres la verdad del Evangelio. Les dirás sin temor que Dios los ama, que se ha hecho hombre por ellos y ha muerto en la cruz para salvarlos.


