# Make a Gift through an IRA Charitable Rollover

- The IRA Charitable Rollover has been extended through 2012 and 2013. This extension allows individuals 70½ or older to move up to \$100,000 from their IRAs directly to qualified charities such as your parish, Archbishop's Annual Appeal, the Archdiocese of Newark, or another archdiocesan institution without having to pay income taxes on the donated money.
- However, you will need to act fast to take advantage of the 2012 tax year. Qualified distributions made by February 1, 2013, may be counted retroactively for the 2012 tax year. Also, if you took a distribution from an IRA in December 2012, you may make a contribution to a qualified charity before February 1, 2013 and treat this as a direct transfer.

# SPOTLIGHT COURSES

The SPOTLIGHT program, sponsored by the Catechetical Office of the Archdiocese of Newark, offers introductory courses in Catholic teachings and scripture for adults. If you haven't had a recent opportunity to update your knowledge of our faith, consider taking a SPOTLIGHT course. Several courses focus on the main teachings of the Church as found in the Catechism of the Catholic Church. There are also courses on the Old Testament and the New Testament. Course 3: Spotlight on Morality "Our Moral Life: Restrictions or Possibilities" will be offered on Saturday, January 19, 2013 (snow date, February 2), at the Church of the Immaculate Heart of Mary in Scotch Plains. The presenter for this course will be Fr. Michael A. Saporito, pastor of St. Helen in Westfield.

Course 5: Spotlight on the Old Testament: "Ancient Stories Ever New: Revisiting the 'Old Testament' " will be offered on Saturday, April 20, 2013, at the Church of St. John the Evangelist in Bergenfield. The presenter for this course will be Sr. Barbara Moore, O.P., D.Min., Associate Professor of Theology and Pastoral Ministry at Caldwell College.

Course 6: Spotlight on the New Testament: "The Word Enlightens our Faith, Fortifies our Hope, Inflames our Love" will be offered on Saturday, March 2, 2013, at the Church of St. Henry in Bayonne. The presenter for this course will be Fr. John D. Gabriel, Director of Vocations for the Archdiocese of Newark.
