This extension allows individuals 70½ or older to move up to \$100,000 from their IRAs directly to qualified charities such as your parish, Archbishop's Annual Appeal, the Archdiocese of Newark, or another archdiocesan institution without having to pay income taxes on the donated money.

However, you will need to act fast to take advantage of the 2012 tax year. Qualified distributions made by February 1, 2013, may be counted retroactively for the 2012 tax year. Also, if you took a distribution from an IRA in December 2012, you may make a contribution to a qualified charity before February 1, 2013 and treat this as a direct transfer.
