Fighting Fraud



Many of us are very trusting souls. Indeed, a substantial part of human interaction involves trust. Many people act with good will, but there are always a few who have devious intentions. Na-

tional Fraud Awareness Week (August 1-7) was designated to remind people that it is important to protect essential information from those who would want to use it for their own benefit. Scams are an attempt to gain money or some other goods by falsely representing a situation. One common one involves a person pretending to be a grandchild in trouble who calls asking to be wired money in a distant country. Never be too quick to wire money without checking with someone. Another common type of fraud is the appearance of extra charges on an online purchase. Always double check a credit card statement to make sure you are only paying for what you ordered. Never give out your Social Security number or birth date to someone who calls you. Always protect these important parts of your identity. The best way to fight fraud is to be aware that it exists, and to be ready to contact authorities if you suspect that it is occurring.
