SPOTLIGHT COURSES

The SPOTLIGHT program, sponsored by the Catechetical Office of the Archdiocese of Newark. offers introductory courses in Catholic teachings and scripture for adults. If you haven't had a recent opportunity to update your knowledge of our faith, consider taking a SPOTLIGHT course. Several courses focus on the main teachings of the Church as found in the Catechism of the Catholic Church. There are also courses on the Old Testament and the New Testament. Each course is completed in a single one day session on a Saturday, 9:30 AM - 3:30 PM. SPOTLIGHT is open to the general public. However, catechists, teachers and leaders in parish religious education programs, Catholic elementary schools, RCIA and adult faith formation are encouraged to earn doctrinal certification through these courses.

The following topics, locations and dates are offered in the coming weeks:

October 5, 2013 - Spotlight on the New Testament, "The Word Enlightens our Faith, Fortifies our Hope, Inflames our Love" (course 6) will be offered at St. John in Bergenfield. The presenter will be Fr. John D. Gabriel, Pastor of St. James in Springfield. October 12, 2013 - Spotlight on Prayer: "God's Thirst," (course 4) will be offered at St. James in Springfield. The presenter will be Fr. Terrence J. Moran, C.Ss.R., Director of the Office of Peace, Justice and Ecological Integrity of the Sisters of Charity of Saint Elizabeth, Convent Station.

October 19, 2013 - Spotlight on Sacraments: "Live in the Love of the Holy Trinity" (course 2) will be offered at Our Lady of the Blessed Sacrament in Roseland. The presenter will be Msgr. Gerard H. McCarren, Associate Professor of Systematic Theology and Spiritual Director at Immaculate Conception Seminary School of Theology, Seton Hall University.

November 2, 2013 - Spotlight on Faith: "The Creed: Our Heritage of Faith" (course 1) will be offered at St. Henry in Bayonne. The presenter will be Dr. Sylvia McGeary, Assistant Professor of Religious Studies at Felician College in Lodi.

The two other courses in the series, Morality (Course 3) and Old Testament (course 5), will be among those offered in the spring. **Registration is \$40 per person per course**, which includes lunch.
