

Safeguarding Children and Addressing Abuse



The Catholic Church Is **Battling Sexual Abuse**

While most media focus over the past ten or more years has been on the incidents of sexual abuse within the Church, little has been said about the many positive steps that the Catholic Church has taken to address the issue. Dioceses across the country, and especially the Archdiocese of Newark, have instituted compassionate outreach to victims and support services, training and background checks for staff and volunteers, training for children and youth, codes of conduct, reporting requirements to civil authorities, independent Review Boards to investigate allegations and recommend actions under Canon law for offenders, as well as other initiatives.

To date, the Catholic Church is the only youth-serving organization in the country - private or public -- to undertake such a comprehensive program to create and promulgate safe environments for children and young people.

Independent auditors from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops have found the Archdiocese of Newark to be fully compliant with the requirements of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People in every year since audits began in 2003.



Day 1: NJ ► Washington DC ► Virginia

In the morning the bus tour will take you to the National Cathedral in Washington DC then we will proceed to Luray Cavern in Virginia. Afterwards you will enjoy and head to the hotel for the evening.

Day 2: Virginia ► Tennessee

In the morning after breakfast the bus tour will proceed to Tennessee and the Great Smoky Mountain National Park. The Greak Smoky Mountains are among the oldest mountains in the world, formed perhaps 200–300 million years ago with the elevation in the park ranging from 875 to 6,643 ft. You will also have an opportunity to ride on one of the biggest cablecar/train to the top of the mountain. In the evening we will enjoy the Dixie Stampede Dinner & Show.

Day 3: Tennessee

In the morning the bus tour will bring you to the Red Ruby Falls at Lookout Mountain which is one of the southeast favorite destinations. This massive waterfall, thundering over 300 gallons of water per minute, has been a family favorite for travelers for over 75 years. Afterwards you will proceed to Rock City Garden featuring massive ancient rock formations, gardens with over 400 native plant species, and breathtaking panoramic views. In the afternoon, the bus tour will go to the Lost Sea, which is America's largest underground lake. At the bottom of the cave you will board a glass-bottom boat for an exciting trip on the Lost Sea.

Day 4: Tennesse ► NJ

After breakfast, the bus tour will leave the hotel and travel back to Philadelphia, PA and see the Reading Terminal Market. Then we will proceed to Long Wood Gardens, which now encompasses 1,050 acres of Gardens, woodlands, and meadows. You will enjoy exquisite flowers, majestic trees, and opulent architecture with 20 indoor and 20 outdoor gardens, where you beauty of every turn. There are over 11,000 types of plants and more fountains than any other garden in the US. Afterwards, the bus will travel back to New Jersey.



Meet The New Priests of the Archdiocese of Newark

Father Nelson Yobani Oyola Garcia

Fr. Oyola came to the U.S. in 2004 from Colombia, where he was born 32 years ago in Villahermosa Tolima. "I always wanted to be a priest," he said, crediting the Daughters of Charity and the parish priests in his hometown with nurturing his vocation.



"The generosity and love the priests and consecrated religious had for the people gave me a deep desire to want to serve the Lord," he said. "I recall with great love and appreciation my family's support and love, which helped my vocation to grow in my heart." The son of Luis and Maria, he is the youngest of three brothers. He said the parishes of Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Jersey City – where he lived for his first five years in the U.S. – and Saint Francis de Sales in Lodi, became part of his family. He also attended Saint Andrew's College Seminary, where he earned a bachelor's degree in philosophy before beginning his theological studies. He celebrated his first Mass at Holy Trinity in Hackensack, where he served as a deacon. We will continue to introduce the 12 new priests of the Archdiocese throughout the summer.
