



## Evangelization Corner .....

## "Justice"

#### SCRIPTURE:

John the Baptist saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world... I did not know Him,

but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, "On whmever you see the Spirit come down and remain, He is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit" (John 1:29, 33).

At a prayer breakfast in Washington, D.C., in early February, 2006, U2 rock star Bono spoke movingly of our call as human beings of all faiths to work for justice and equality. There is one thing, he said, that al of us of every faith and ideology can agree on:"...that God is with the vulnerable and poor. "He continued:

God is in the slums, in the cardboard boxes where the poor play house. God is in the silence of a mother who has infected her child with a virus that will end both their lives. God is in the cries heard under the rubble of war. God is in the debris of wasted opportunity and lives, and God is with us if we are with them.

This God who is with the vulnerable and poor is with us in the Lamb of God whom John the Baptist points out to us today: John would have been aware of that title used for Isaiah's Suffering Servant who would bring forth justice to the nations...

(Isa 52:13-53:12 and Isa 42:1b; 42:6a). Jesus, the Lamb of God, is that Suffering Servant. In him God suffers with the poor and oppressed in order to bring all people and all nations to freedom and justice.

Prayer: Jesus, you who suffer in the poor and afflicted, open our eyes and hearts to your presence in those unjustly treated in our world. Fill us with compassion and energy to reach out to them and to work for justice. This we pray, trusting in your Spirit who lives within us. Amen.

When Jesus asked the Samaritan woman for a drink of water, He opened the door for a life changing relationship with Him. Scrip-


ture says her testimony drew many others to Him as well. We, too, must be ready to respond whenever and wherever the Lord speaks to us and be prepared for it to change our lives!
