Mom and Dad: You Are The Domestic Church

Did you know that a little community of faith lives in your home? That's right. You and your kids are the domestic church. Just this

share it with others. So what does this mean? How can you build up your domestic church?

A good start is to become com-

for children to see their parents place their trust in God.

Other ways to strengthen your domestic church are to share family activities such as enlisting the help of your children in the creation of a small sacred space in your home for prayer or reflection that includes prayer books, a children's Bible, and art and symbols related to the particular liturgical season. Reading stories from the bible together and inviting your children to compare the experience of the characters to an experience of daily life is a great way to instill a love for scripture in your children and also help adults gain new insights. Implant in your children a charitable and empathic heart by volunteering to help those who are less fortunate; also discuss the teachings of Jesus as they related to issues of Catholic social teachings (appropriate to the age of the child). Also, just as parents remember their wedding anniversary, other sacramental anniversaries such as your child's baptism can be celebrated. Everyone loves to hear stories about themselves and children are no different. These are wonderful opportunities to remind your child why his or her baptism was important to you.

It's also good to remember that children have spiritual wisdom to share. A child is able to see and comprehend God with a purity and authenticity that most adults have lost. Listen to your child's questions or observations about the faith and continue to encourage that level of loving trust. You may notice your own faith growing in response.

past June, speaking in part on the topic of Christian families, Pope Francis said "Families are the domestic church where Jesus grows in the love of a married couple, in the lives of their children." This statement challenges us to recall that the Church is not a location or a building, it is us: the community of Christians. As members of this community we are called to live out and share the Good News of Jesus Christ in a way that both reflects our faith and leads others to loving God and neighbor more deeply. As parents, it should come as no surprise that we are our child's first and best example of the faith. Our role is to share it by word and example so our sons and daughters grow up knowing they are beloved children of God, have a place in God's plan, and can live out their Catholic faith and

portable praying with your children from an early age. Pray from your heart; speak prayers of gratitude for all that God has given you, speak prayers asking for what your family and others need, and of course offer prayers of praise. Making a sign of the cross with your thumb on your infant's head and allowing older siblings to do the same, teaching your preschooler how to make the sign of the cross and recite simple prayers and hymns, making family mealtime prayer a habit, taking a few quiet moments before bedtime to pray for family members and friends, and preparing your children to join the community in prayer on Sunday Mass are all beautiful ways to pass your faith on to your children. Safeguarding Children and Addressing Abuse

The Archdiocese Addresses Victims' Concerns



The Archdiocese takes very seriously the needs of victims who approach the Church seeking healing from abuse. In addition to offering counseling and other support services, in appropriate cases, the Archdiocese provides reasonable compensation to those victims seeking a financial settlement of their civil claim, even after the statute of limitations has lapsed. Settlements are not confidential unless requested by the victim, and may include funding for continued psychological counseling.

The Archdiocese's general liability insurance coverage is the sole source of funds used to pay abuse settlements. Although the Archdiocese, parishes and schools pay premiums to purchase insurance, no parish or school assets, Archdiocesan assets or Annual Appeal or other fundraising collections are used to pay civil claims related to abuse cases.
