

## Safeguarding Children and Addressing Abuse



### The Archdiocese Addresses Victims' Concerns

The Archdiocese takes very seriously the needs of victims who approach the Church seeking healing from abuse. In addition to offering counseling and other support services, in appropriate cases, the Archdiocese provides reasonable compensation to those victims seeking a financial settlement of their civil claim, even after the statute of limitations has lapsed. Settlements are not confidential unless requested by the victim, and may include funding for continued psychological counseling.

The Archdiocese's general liability insurance coverage is the sole source of funds used to pay abuse settlements. Although the Archdiocese, parishes and schools pay premiums to purchase insurance, no parish or school assets, Archdiocesan assets or Annual Appeal or other fundraising collections are used to pay civil claims related to abuse cases.

# 2015 Lenten Regulations

1. **The days of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.
2. **The obligation to observe the laws of Fast and Abstinence "substantially", or as a whole, is a serious obligation.**
3. **The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance,** but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.

On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted, and two (2) smaller meals, which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast. On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

4. **The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty\*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, February 22, 2015 to The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, May 31, 2015.**

*\*Canon 920, §1. All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.*

## Feast Day of St Bakhita

The feast day of St Josephine Bakhita, February 8, has been designated as the first International Day of Prayer and Awareness against Human Trafficking. The day is intended to raise awareness and to encourage reflection on the violence and injustice that affect the numerous victims of trafficking. The observance is being promoted for all dioceses, parishes and church groups.

Josephine Bakhita was kidnapped as a child and sold into slavery in Sudan and Italy. Once Josephine was freed, she dedicated her life to sharing her testament of deliverance from slavery and comforting the poor and suffering. The USCCB promotes this day by encouraging Catholics throughout the country to observe the international day of prayer through Mass, prayer vigils, and other events to raise awareness about human trafficking in their parishes and communities. In the words of our Holy Father Pope Francis, may we be "slaves no more, but brothers and sisters."

**O St Bakhita, assist all those who are trapped in a state of slavery; Intercede with God on their behalf so that they will be released from their chains of captivity. Those whom man enslaves, let God set free.**



## Two Years Ago: Pope Benedict XVI's Resignation Stunned The World

Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI announced his resignation on the morning of February 11, 2013. It took effect on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of the same month. The first papal resignation in nearly six centuries led to the election of Pope Francis, and a dramatic reshaping of the church's style and tone.
