ARCHDIOCESE OF NEWARK 2010 LENTEN REGULATIONS



1. The days of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent are **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted.

Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast.

On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten.

Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

2. The obligation to observe the laws of Fast and Abstinence substantially, or as a whole, is a serious obligation.

3. The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.

4. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the **First Sunday of Lent, February 21, 2010 to the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, May 30, 2010.**

*Canon 920, §1. *All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.*

REGULACIONES PARA LA CUARESMA



De acuerdo a la ley de abstinencia de la iglesia, todos los **viernes** durante la cuaresma son considerados **dia de abstinencia de carne**, y toda persona de 14 años en adelante tiene la obligación de obedecer.

Esta ley también quiere estimular a los padres para que se aseguren que los menores que no están bajo la ley de ayuno y abstinencia sean educados con un sentido auténtico de penitencia.

Sentido de la Cuaresma.

Para nosotros, los cristianos de hoy, Cuaresma es un tiempo de conversión, de renovación y de penitencia.

Ahora, **¿qué significa conversión para nosotros?** Debe ser un cambio serio, profundo, total, un cambio de mentalidad, de actitudes interiores, pero que se expresa también en la vida exterior.

La Cuaresma es un camino hacia la Pascua, que es la fiesta más importante de la Iglesia por ser la resurrección de Jesús.


