La Eucaristía como sacramento



La eucaristía es el sacramento en el cual bajo las especies de pan y vino, Jesucristo se halla verdadera, real y substancialmente presente, con su cuerpo, su sangre, su alma y su divinidad.

A este sacramento se le denomina de muchas maneras dada su riqueza infinita.

- Es el Banquete del Señor porque es la Cena que Cristo celebró con sus apóstoles justo antes de comenzar la pasión. (Cfr. 1 Col. 11, 20)
- Fracción del pan porque este rito fue el que utilizó Jesús cuando bendecía y distribuía el pan, sobre todo en la Última Cena. Los discípulos de Emaús lo reconocieron—después de la resurrección—por este gesto y los primeros cristianos llamaron de esta manera a sus asambleas eucarísticas. (Cfr. Mt. 26,25; Lc.24, 13-35; Hech. 2, 42-46).
- También, se le dice asamblea eucarística porque se celebra en la asamblea—reunión—de los fieles.
- Santo sacrificio, porque se actualiza el sacrificio de Cristo. Es memorial de la pasión, muerte y resurrección de Jesucristo.
- Comunión, porque es la unión íntima con Cristo que nos hace partícipes de su Cuerpo y de su Sangre.
- Didaché, es el sentido primero de la “comunión de los santos que se menciona en el símbolo de los Apóstoles.
- Misa, posee un sentido de misión, llevar a los demás lo que se ha recibido de Dios en el sacramento.

Evangelization Corner.....

Reflecting On The Gospel - Maybe you've heard or used the statement, "It's not all about you." This is said to people who are concerned about only that affects them. They don't stop to think about how something might be affecting others. In today's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable that helps us see how we cannot think about ourselves and, at the same time, be faithful to him and his teachings.

Jesus talks of a man who is accused of "squandering" his employer's resources and about to lose his job.

Sharing Ideas - What can we do when we are tempted to be selfish, to think only of our own wants and needs?

Do we take Jesus seriously? I often wonder if we do. Do we take him seriously when he talks about anger: Matthew 5:21-26. Do we take him seriously when he tells us that being angry at a sister or brother makes us a candidate for passing judgment?

How often do we think before we call a sister or brother a "fool"? Remember that we are made in the image and likeness of God. Therefore, we are to see Jesus in one another.
