Evangelization Corner.....

Reflecting On The Gospel - In today's Gospel, Jesus talks about things we don't like to think about; war, earthquakes, starvation, diseases and strange things happening in the sky. He talks about "giving testimony" in His name even when we're faced with powerful authority figures.

Jesus is not trying to scare us into being His faithful followers. Rather, He wants us to be realistic. He wants us to face the facts about this world. Following Jesus today is very difficult. In fact, Jesus says that his followers will face some very tough situations - that even family members and friends may not remain caring and loyal.

Through all of these real-life possibilities, Jesus says, "Not a hair on your head will be destroyed"; we can feel secure because faith in Jesus will bring us the peace and joy that lasts no matter what happens.

Sharing Ideas - Tell of a time in your life or in the life of someone you know when, despite things being very tough, faith in Jesus brought peace to the situation.
