Evangelization Corner.....

Reflecting On The Gospel - It is healthy and acceptable to be proud of ourselves when we accomplish a goal. God gives us special gifts and skills to be used for our own good and the good of others. But when we speak of another's failures to make our accomplishments look even better, we sin.

Jesus makes this clear in the story He tells in today's Gospel. The story is about two men praying. One prays with the boastful self-righteousness, about not being like others. The other man prays with humility; he keeps his eyes lowered and beats his breast in sorrow for his sins. In Jesus story, both men were sinners; we are all sinners. Both are loved by God, but the first denies his sinfulness before God. The other man, sees himself for what he is. He knows that he needs God's help to become a better person and as he humbles and is sorry for his sins, he is aware of his neediness.


