October 23, 2011 – Part 4 of 7

On November 27, 2011, the English speaking Church in the USA will begin using a new translation of the prayers used at Mass (*The Roman Missal*). In order to become familiar with these changes before they are implemented, samples of the new texts will be printed here. Please check here weekly.

Nicene Creed

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, **of all things visible and invisible.**

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, **the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages.**

God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God,

begotten, not made, **consubstantial with the Father;** through him all things were made

For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven,

and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, **he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on**

the third day

in accordance with the Scriptures.

He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, **who with the Father and the Son**

is adored and glorified, **who** has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church.

I confess one baptism for the forgiveness of sins

and I look forward to the resurrection

of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Dios, que todo lo ve y todo lo conoce, se da cuenta de nuestros sentimientos en contra de nuestros semejantes. El nos exige amar como El nos ama. Y El nos amó hasta la muerte... a pesar de nuestras faltas, de nuestras infidelidades para con El, de nuestros "no" a sus deseos.

Un buen ejercicio de oración para aprender a perdonar es precisamente la frase del Padre Nuestro: "Perdona nuestras ofensas como nosotros perdonamos a los que nos ofenden". Al rezar el Padre Nuestro y al repetir esta frase, se puede pensar en los que nos han ofendido y ponerlos ante el Padre celestial, tal vez diciendo interiormente al Señor: "Tú sabes, Señor, lo que me cuesta. Tú sabes, Señor, lo que siento. No puedo perdonar. Pero si quiero perdonar, porque Tú me lo pides. Perdona Tú en mi, Señor.

Debemos buscar a Dios en la oración. Debemos orar para perdonar.

Reflecting On The Gospel - Sometimes we find it hard to understand what Jesus teaches us in Scripture; we have to ponder his words in our hearts and understand the culture of his time.
