


Thanksgiving Food Pantry Update

On November 27, 2011, the English speaking Church in the USA will begin using a new translation of the prayers used at Mass (*The Roman Missal*). In order to become familiar with these changes before they are implemented, samples of the new texts will be printed here. Please check here weekly.

Communion Rite

Priest: The peace of the Lord be with you always.

People: **And with your spirit.**

Priest: **Behold** the Lamb of God, **behold him** who takes away the sins of the world.

Blessed are those called **to the supper of the Lamb.**

All: Lord, I am not worthy

that you should enter under my roof,
but only say the word
and **my soul** shall be healed.

Concluding Rite

Priest: The Lord be with you.

People: **And with your spirit.**



El Catecismo de la Iglesia nos explica por qué tenemos un Credo (Rf. 185-197). Desde Su origen, la Iglesia Apostólica expresó su fe en formulas breves para todos.

Esta sintesis de fe no ha sido hecha segun opinions humanas, sino que se ha tomado de Toda la Escritura lo mas importante, para dar en su integridad la única enseñanza de la fe. A esta se le llama “Profesión de fe”, y también se le llama Credo, ya que la primera palabra en ella es “Creo”.

Entre los simbolos de la fe dos ocupan un lugar muy particular en la vida de la Iglesia, estos son: El símbolo de los Apóstoles y El Símbolo de Nicea-Constantinopla.

El Credo de los apóstoles, es el corto, es llamado de los apóstoles porque es considerado con justicia como el resumen fiel de la fe de los apóstoles. Es el antiguo simbolo bautismal de la Iglesia Romana. Su gran autoridad proviene del hecho de que es el simbolo que guarda la Iglesia Romana, la que fue sede de Pedro, el primero de los apóstoles, y a la cual él llevó a la doctrina común.

El Credo de Nicea-Constantinopla, es más largo por ser mas explicito y lo rezamos todos los domingos en la Misa. Debe su gran autoridad al hecho de que es fruto de los dos primeros Concilios ecuménicos, como su nombre lo indica respectivamente Concilio de Nicea año 325 y el Concilio Constantinopla año 381. Sigue siendo hoy el símbolo común de todas las Iglesias de Oriente y Occidente.

Recitar con fe el Credo es recordar nuestro Bautismo y entrar en communion con Dios Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, ese también entrar en comunion con toda la Iglesia que nos transmite la Fe y en el seno de la cual creemos.

Evangelization Corner.....

Reflecting On The Gospel - The parable tells us about three servants who must account for their master's money, however, this parable is not just about money. Rather, Jesus teaches us that the gift of faith is ours to share. At Baptism, we become children of God and members of the Church. When we fail to share our faith with others, we end up sad and alone, as though we were outside in the dark night just like the third servant.
