TERESIANS CELEBRATE 140 YEARS

The Teresians, a Catholic woman's sodality that supports scholarships and development at St. Peter's University will celebrate the 140th anniversary of its founding at a special Noon Mass **Saturday, April 27, 2013** at St. Aedan's Church on Bergen Avenue, Jersey City. The Mass will be followed with a luncheon at the new Mac Mahon Student Center of St. Peter's University on Glenwood Avenue.

The organization (formally known as the Sodality of the Children of Mary of St. Teresa) was founded in 1873 at St. Peter's Church in Downtown Jersey City, and its primary mission was assisting the poor of the parish. During the early years the Teresians contributed to various charitable groups dealing with the poor, and

donated to the building fund of the original St. Aloysius Academy on Grand Street. Since the early 1920s, it funded various projects at the then St. Peter's College including the building of the College Chapel. In recent years the Teresians established an annual scholarship for a deserving student and continue to contribute to the general development fund of the University.

Directed by the University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey–University Behavioral HealthCare, the confidential program’s focus is on caring for the mental and emotional health of mothers of children with special needs of all ages. By dialing the Mom2Mom helpline (877-914-MOM2), callers can: talk to other mothers of children with special needs who have been trained as peer counselors who can offer support; gain access to a Resource Database; and get information on Mom2Mom Support Groups in their area.
