Safeguarding Children and Addressing Abuse

THE ARCHDIOCESE ADDRESSES VICTIMS' CONCERNS

The Archdiocese takes very seriously the needs of victims who approach the Church seeking healing from abuse. In addition to offering counseling and other support services, in appropriate cases, the Archdiocese provides reasonable compensation to those victims seeking a financial settlement of their civil claim, even after the statute of limitations has

lapsed. Settlements are not confidential unless requested by the victim, and may include funding for continued psychological counseling.

The Archdiocese's general liability insurance coverage is the sole source of funds used to pay abuse settlements. Although the Archdiocese, parishes and schools pay premiums to purchase insurance, no parish or school assets, Archdiocesan assets or Annual Appeal or other fundraising collections are used to pay civil claims related to abuse cases.

ARCHDIOCESE OF NEWARK 2014 LENTEN REGULATIONS



1. The days of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent are **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted and **two (2) smaller meals, which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity.** Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast.

On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

2. The obligation to observe the laws of Fast and Abstinence "substantially", or as a whole, is a serious obligation.

3. The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.

4. The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the **First Sunday of Lent, March 9, 2014 to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, June 15, 2014.**

*Canon 920, §1. *All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.*

An Urgent Need for Blood Donations

There is an urgent, critical need for volunteer blood donors as a result of the current cold weather conditions and donors canceling because of illness.

According to Community Blood Services of New Jersey, which supplies blood and blood products to more than 18 hospitals in New Jersey, there is less than a one-day supply on hand in our area to meet the needs of patients.

All eligible blood donors are asked to call 201-251-3703 now to schedule appointments at one of Community Blood Services donor centers to help rebuild the fragile supply.

All blood types are needed, but especially Type O negative. There has been a continuing shortage of O negative blood donors because they represent only 7% of the population. Type O negative blood also is in most demand by hospitals because Type O donors are "universal donors" whose blood can be transfused into anyone in emergency rooms and trauma situations when there is no time for blood typing.
